INCAS - Increasing Impact in International Work Placements

Research has shown that participation in mobility, the experience of living and working in another country, leads to greater employment opportunities. The Eurobarometer on mobility says that 59% of people without work who moved country found a job within 12 months. However to participate in international mobility is a greater challenge for disadvantaged young people, with less than 8% taking part.

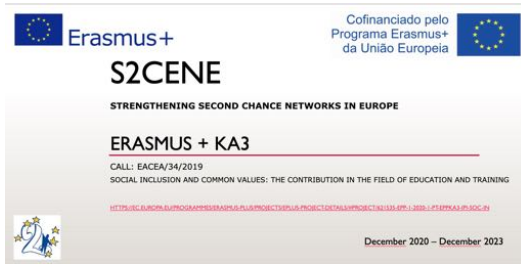

STRENGTHENING SECOND CHANCE NETWORKS in EUROPE

E2C is involved in a new KA 3 Project, which started at 1st of December and will end in November 2024.

This project is exactly for the develop and installation of National Networks of Second Chance Education.

This project has 3 main aims:

1. creation of Second Chance Initiatives and Schools in 2 countries of the partnership (BG and HR);
2. establishment of formal national networks of Second Chance Schools in 3 countries of the partnership (PT, BG and HR);
3. institutional and positioning reinforcement of the European network of Second Chance Schools (E2C Europe).

With these 3 main aims E2C is in line with the new structure of E2C as a European Network for Networks of Second Chance Education.
